LAKE TRUST TAKES ACTION TO SUPPORT LOCAL COMMUNITIES AT EIGHTH ANNUAL POWERED BY GOOD DAY

322 team members from the Brighton-based credit union volunteered at over 39 local nonprofit organizations, including Gleaners Community Food Bank, Kenzie's Be Café, Clothing INC and more

BRIGHTON, Mich. Oct. 27, 2025 – Lake Trust Credit Union (Lake Trust), a community-based credit union serving nearly 200,000 members and businesses throughout Michigan, supported 39 Michigan-based nonprofit organizations as part of its eighth annual Powered by Good Day.
